Mathais Stabinger was a German flutist, clarinetist and composer. He lived most of his life living in Paris, Milan, Bologna, Naples and finally Vienna.

The two movements used in today’s worship are in Stabinger’s collection held at the Moravian Music Foundation in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. The collection was copied by Johann Friederich Peter in 1790, the music director in the Salem Congregation.

The German text of Henriette Louise van Hayn (1724-1782), is a metrical version of Psalm 23. The English version was translated by Moravian Bishop, Frederick William Foster (1760-1835). This 2011 edition blends her beloved text, the hymn tune HAYN (Herrnhut c. 1740) and Dr. Biggam’s dance-like flute duet into a joyful hymn of praise.
