### **Sperling-Zimmerman Memorial Home:**

The Sperling-Zimmerman Memorial Home is a duplex that was built in 1962 as a residence for retired clergy located at 149 W. Indian Avenue and 151 West Indian Avenue, in Gnadenhutzen, Ohio. Each apartment is all electric and has 900 square feet of space with a basement and single-car garage on the lower level.

One representative from each Moravian congregation in Tuscarawas County and an appointee of the Moravian Church Northern Province oversee the operation of the home. The board members are elected annually at their Church Council. All representatives on the board serve without pay and faithfully and wisely supervise the resources of the home. Meetings are held throughout the year.
