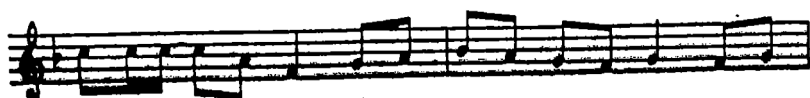

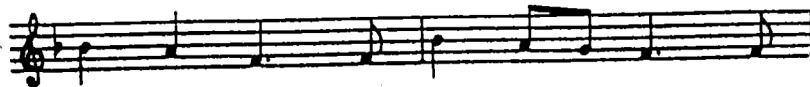

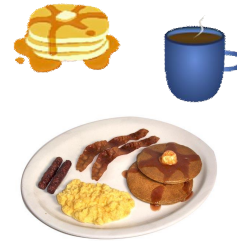


Change Can Make a *Difference*
